

NEW ROUTES



CRACKHOUSE ALLEY

10a. Beefcake 5.9 **

Start as for **Meatcake** but head right into a splitter crack, follow it to its end, and then move back left to join **Meatcake** for its finish. (Mixed) 55 ft. FFA: *Cole Fennel 2008*

10b. Tarzan 5.10c PG **

Climb **Beefcake** but instead of finishing on **Meatcake**, climb the bolted face just right of it. (Mixed/1 bolt) 55 ft. FFA: *Cole Fennel 2008*

25. Cardboard Beer Girl 5.10a PG **

This route follows the thin crack up the middle of the slab just right of **The Wave**. At the end of the crack halfway up trend up and right to the first bolt. There is a bit of a runout between the last trad gear and the first bolt with a crux move just before the first bolt. (Mixed/2 bolts/anchor) 55 ft. FFA: *Cole Fennel/Stark Ligon 2007*

26. Three Times One Minus One 5.11c PG *

This is the blunt arête located sixty feet left of **The Mud, the Blood & The Beer**. The climb is still a bit dirty and the bolts are somewhat spaced. (Sport/5 bolts/anchor) 55 ft. FFA: *Stark Ligon/John Daniel 2007*

CONFEDERATE CRACKS

3a. Diamond Crystal Speedboat 5.11d * PG

This route goes up the middle of the green dirty slab approximately fifteen feet right of **Door Prize**. (Sport/5 bolts/anchor) FFA: *Cole Fennel/Stark Ligon 2007*

3b. Fools Gold 5.8 *

Fist crack just right of **Diamond Crystal Speedboat**. FA: *Chris Banks/Stark Ligon*

4a. Yuns 5.10+ PG **

This next route begins at the lowest point of the buttress, right of **Mountain Meadow Massacre**. This climbs a small seam through two roofs followed by runout and dirty chickenhead climbing to the **Mountain Meadow Massacre** anchors. RACK: to 3.5" Note: the crux is well protected by a gray TCU and a small brass offset but is strenuous to place. The upper part is moderate but dangerous. (Trad/anchor) FFA: *Cole Fennel/Mike Munger 2007*

29a. Amores Perros 5.12c ***

This route ascends the black blunt arête ten feet left of **Toxic Dementia**. Sustained climbing leads up this unsuspecting difficult slab. (Sport/7 bolts/anchor) 50 ft. FFA: *2008*

THE TITANIC

6a. Man Overboard 5.10b ***

Steep arête fifteen feet left of **Port Side**, start from **Cradle of the Deep** then traverse right low on jug holds to first bolt. (Sport/4 bolts/share anchor) 45 ft. FFA: *Nate Moore/Clay Frisbie 2008*

THE NORTH FORTY

12a. Hardly Spot 'Er 5.9 **

Directly across the corridor from **Harry Butthole Potter**. Fingercrack on the right or flake system on the left leads to great small handcrack which passes through pocketed bulge to top of separated block from main wall. Belay and rap from obvious huge chickenhead. (Trad/no anchor) 45 ft. FFA: *Jeremy Collins 2006*

12b. Divebomb 5.10a R

Right of **Mine Mine Mine**, a large inset crack that leads up to loose rock. (Trad/no anchor) 45 ft. FFA: *Unknown*

12c. Action Hotdog 5.6 **

Big holds lead up this route, good beginner route. (Sport/3 bolts/anchor) 40 ft. FFA: *Unknown*

12d. Perfect Hair Forever 5.7 ***

Face climb up middle of face. (Sport/4 bolts/anchor) 40 ft. FFA: *Jason Roy 2008*

12e. Uncle Grandfather 5.6 **

Low angle scoop chimney that angles up and left. (Trad/anchor) 45 ft. FFA: *Unknown*

20a. The Season of the Storm 5.10a ***

Face just right of dihedral with roof low and a roof high, moderate climbing with a crux before reaching the second roof, slightly reach dependent crux. (Sport/7 bolts/anchor) 65 ft. FFA: *Jason Roy 2008*

31a. Walker - Arkansas Ranger 5.6

The wide dihedral between **Summer Rain** and **Cotton Candy**. (Trad/no anchor) 65 ft. FFA: *Unknown*

37a. Cow killer 5.7+ PG

The juggy face just left of **Dancing Bears**. (Trad/anchor) 50 ft. FFA: *Unknown*

43a. Towely 5.10b **

Start with the first two bolts of **Mr. Hanky** then continue up and left on large holds. (Mixed/no anchor) 40 ft. FFA: *Unknown*

45a. Guides Corner 5.7

The short dihedral with anchors, just around the corner and right of **Petrified**. (Trad/anchor) 40 ft. FFA: *Unknown*

59a. Sure thing 5.7

The dihedral just right of **Tres Equis**. (Trad) 40 ft. FFA: *Unknown*

68a. Marek's Golden Way 5.9 *

On the opposite side of the **Kindergarten Wall** from the guide routes is a steep face. On the far right is a crack that goes up through two bulges. It is just left of a tree and the branches will be on you as you climb. Don't break the branches! Also beware of THIN rock. The holds definitely can break on this one. (Trad/no anchor) 35 ft. FFA: *Bryan Hall/Brena Lepore 2008*

68b. Mossy Revelations 5.9 PG

To the left around the corner from the guide routes on the **Kindergarten Wall** is a shallow flake/dihedral that appears rather slopey. Climb up and left on the dihedral feature to finish above. (Trad/no anchor) 35 ft. FFA: *Bryan Hall/Brena Lepore 2008*

68c. The Poison Ivy Route 5.7

A low angle dihedral system just left and around the corner from **Too Short to Drive the Short Bus**. (Trad) 35 ft. FFA: *Jason Roy*

68d. Too Short to Drive the Short Bus 5.9 **

The bolted, northwest arête on the **Kindergarten Boulder**. (Sport/anchor) 35 ft. FFA: *Aaron Roy 2008*

THE GOAT CAVE

1a. Remember Sarah 5.7+ **

This is the obvious dihedral crack on the **Goat Cave** bluff. You will know you are at the base of the route by the two foot deep soil of Goat's dung and enormous roof to the right. A 5.7+ move leads to the dihedral crack that is lined with jug hand holds. 45 ft. (Trad) FFA: *Unknown*

MULLET BUTTRESS

0a. De Nada 5.10a *

This route is a short, right angling finger crack, the crux is located low with moderate climbing above, This route is located fifty feet to the left of **Mixed Max**. (Trad) 60 ft. FFA: *Clay Frisbie 2001*

1b. Bow Flex 5.6

Large, left angling chimney easily visible from the road. (Trad) 50 ft FFA: *Unknown*

1c. The White Stripes 5.10d ***

This route ascends the face just left of the two obvious white vertical streaks. (Sport/5 bolts/anchor) 50 ft. FFA: *Jason Roy 2008*

MIDDLE EAST

1a. Short Cut 5.7 *

Short dihedral crack on the left side of **Tool Buttress**. (Trad) FFA: *Unknown*

9. Nipple Stimulation 5.10a **

This is located about 50' to 100' to the right of **Bum Fight**. It's very obvious, because the bolts are shiny! (Mixed) 55 ft. FFA: *Todd Miller 2000*

10. Hard On 5.8+ **

This is located about 50' to 100' right of **Nipple Stimulation**. Its a left angling crack, just right of a low lying roof, mixed with two bolts. Only one of which can be seen from the start. (Mixed) 55 ft. FFA: *Tony Morris*

11. Direct Hard On 5.7+ *

This starts from the same location as the previous and climbs a crack system straight up to a belay tree. (Trad) 55 ft. FFA: *Tony Morris*

ROMAN WALL

2a. Gaius 5.7 **

This is the broken dihedral crack to the left of **Commodus**. Moderate climbing leads to the ledge half way up the face. (Trad) 45 ft. FFA: *Unknown*

THE CLIFFS OF INSANITY

15a. Swamp Rat 5.8 ***

This sport route ascends the north facing wall left of **Fashion Sense**. (Sport/7 bolts/anchor) 70 ft. FFA: *Jason Roy 2008*

THE FAR EAST

17a. Stinky Boots 5.10d **

This route is just left of **Kinky Boots**. (Sport/5 bolts/anchor) 50 ft. FFA: *Cole Fennel 2008*

17b. Kinky Boots 5.10 b/c **

This route is located on the arête left of **First Time Up**. It starts on the right side of the arête with two bolts and a bouldery start (10). It then crosses over to the left side of the arête with more moderate climbing above. (Sport/7 bolts/anchor) 50 ft. FFA: *Bruce Kirkpatrick 2006*

17c. Happy Camper 5.8 *

A broken dihedral crack that is a bit dirty five feet from **First Time Up**. (Trad) 60 ft. FFA: *Unknown*

23a. El Chupacraba 5.10a ***

Just left of **Pills On an Empty Stomach**. 60 ft. (Mixed/4 bolts/anchor) FFA: *Tony Morris*
